Immigration Holds

Effective immediately, to comply with a recent federal court ruling, any Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) requests for holds on inmates being released from custody MUST be signed by a federal magistrate or a federal judge. Any orders or requests that are signed by an official with ICE cannot be honored.

Deputies and all other employees will continue to cooperate with ICE and will share information on any inmates we believe or suspect may not be United States citizens.

If ICE wants to take custody and can accept immediate custody upon the inmate's release from our jail, we will help coordinate an immediate transfer of custody. However, at this time, LCSO staff cannot extend the custody or delay the release of an inmate for transfer to ICE without judicially authorized order to do so.

Additionally, Policy 62980 mmigration Violations" references our compliance with CRS 29-29-103. That statute has been repealed, so any references in policy are null and void.
