



ATTENTION: SALVADORAN TPS HOLDERS

An important message for immigrants with Temporary
Protected Status (TPS) from El Salvador

AUGUST 2023

Over 250,000 Salvadorans have enrolled in Temporary Protected Status (TPS) since the program was announced for that country in 2001. For the past several years there has been an automatic extension of TPS for Salvadorans, but now **re-registration is required to maintain TPS.**

IF YOU HAVE TPS FOR EL SALVADOR AND CONTINUE TO MEET THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS, YOU MUST RE-REGISTER FOR TPS AND APPLY FOR A WORK PERMIT BY SEPTEMBER 10, 2023.

It is strongly recommended to get legal assistance to verify your eligibility and file your application.

The re-registration deadline is September 10, 2023. This will extend TPS for Salvadorans through March 9, 2025. **If you do not re-register by September 10, 2023, your TPS will expire on June 30, 2024.**

This TPS extension is only for current TPS holders. However, in some cases, it may be possible to apply for the first time if you meet certain requirements, including having lived in the United States since February 13, 2001. Consult a legal

THE CURRENT AUTOMATIC EXTENSION OF TPS FOR EL SALVADOR LASTS UNTIL JUNE 30, 2024, BUT YOU MUST RE-REGISTER BY SEPTEMBER 10, 2023 TO MAINTAIN TPS THROUGH MARCH 9, 2025 AND BEYOND.

Fee waivers are available for low-income TPS applicants. Don't let financial concerns be a barrier to applying!
