Policy: Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE); DHS Form I-247 Immigration Detainer-Notice of Action

RATIONALE:

ICE Detainers (DHS Form I-247) will not be honored on advice from legal counsel, unless supported by a federal probable cause hearing.

GUIDELINES:

- ICE Detainers will not be honored unless accompanied with documentation of proof a federal probable cause hearing occurred and such proof is signed by a judge.
- Upon receipt of an ICE Detainer (DHS form I-247) the jailer/booking officer will
 write "Hold Rejected" on the bottom portion of form I-247 and complete the
 Name and title of Officer section and complete the Signature of Officer
 section. Copy of the rejected hold will be placed with the CPD booking sheet.
- If feasible, the requesting immigration officer should be notified of the rejection.
