PRESIDENT OBAMA'S NEW IMMIGRATION PROGRAMS: DEFERRED ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS AND PARENTS

Have you been in the United States for more than five years?

(Since January 1, 2010 or before)

Were you in the United States on November 20, 2014?

Did you come to the United States before you turned 16 years old? OR

Do you have a child who was born in the U.S. or has a green card?

(adult and minor children count)

If so, you may qualify for President Obama's new immigration program that can provide:

- **Deferred action** (protection from deportation)
- A work permit / photo identification card
- A social security number
- California driver's license
- Medi-Cal eligibility
- Ability to travel outside and return to the United States

What can you do now?

- Get **proof of your identity**, like a passport, matricula, school identification card, birth certificate or other identification card with your photograph on it.
- Collect any documentation to show that you were here in the United States on November 20, 2014 and since January 1, 2010. This can include remittance receipts, school records, medical or immunization records, copies of bills, letters that show your address(es) in the United States, attendance records, rent records, church records, gym membership records, credit card and other payment receipts, work paystubs and more.
- **Save your money.** The fee to apply will be \$465. You may also need to pay a legal representative to help you.
- Get a *copy of your criminal history* if you have any criminal record. You will need that information to apply later. Go to http://www.ilrc.org/resources/background-checks to get information on how you can do this yourself.
